Every person employed by RCC is responsible for their own safety and those around them and is also responsible for reporting any accidents or deviations from acceptable working conditions.

Each employee, visitor and subcontractor has the responsibility to follow all safe work procedures, instructions and site rules and must work in a manner which ensures the health and safety of themselves and others around them.
